



## Whittling/Carving Contest Rules

1. Our Whittling/Carving Contest this year is to be completed from any piece of scrap wood you have or any piece of wood where the total length, width and height does not exceed a maximum of 16 inches. Examples: a stick measuring 2" x 2" x 12" = 16", 1" x 1" x 6" = 8". If you choose to Chip Carve or Woodburn on a plate it must not be larger than 8" in diameter. You can also do an egg and we ask that it not exceed a goose sized egg. This is intended to be a whittling project, not a major carving.
2. The project is to be completed and finished with the finish of your choice.
3. The pieces are to be collected and/or turned in by 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, March 16<sup>th</sup>.
4. All projects should be signed or initialed and dated.
5. The whittling project becomes the property of the Lancaster County Woodcarvers, the carvings will be judged and prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place, and then will then be placed in the silent auction.

All proceeds from the carving contest will benefit the Lancaster County Woodcarvers and/or the Jay Herr Education Fund and help with club activities.

We hope you will all participate in the whittling contest. **The contest is open to all exhibitors and Lancaster County Woodcarvers club members.** We're sure you will come up with some great pieces that will generate interest from the show attendees and fellow carvers.
